John Venezia Community Park Pickleball Venue Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between PRCS and PPPA

Objectives:

1) Provide the area residents with Pickleball lessons at Venezia Park and with PRCS plan for use of this location as a venue for amateur Pickleball tournament competition 2) Assist PRCS in the design and maintenance of the Pickleball venue at Venezia Park

MOU Tenets :

1) PPPA participates in Pickleball Court Design/Layout 2) PPPA provides funding for Venezia Pickleball Court/Net Maintenance (such PPPA Board-approved funding is planned not to exceed \$500 per year given the low-maintenance post-tensioned concrete design of these new Venezia courts) 3) Parks & Rec and PPPA plan for using Venezia Park for Pickleball 'overflow' from MVP for the annual Great Plains Regional Pickleball Tournament in 2016 (a possible location for the Women's and Men's Singles bracket) 4) PPPA provides Pickleball Education & Training for local residents (including free introductory lessons and guided play training)

PPPA assists PRCS in adaptive planning to address future Pickleball court growth needs at this park location
