



Cañon City Area Recreation and Park District's Cañon City Classic Pickleball Tournament

Date of play: June 15, 2019

Check in at 8:00 am/Play begins at 9 am

Location: Rouse Park

Entry Deadline: Entries must be received by 5:00 pm on June 6, 2019. You may register online at www.ccrec.org or at the Cañon City Area Recreation and Park District Office, 575 Ash Street. Regardless of how you register, you must create an online account through Active Network, in order to register in the office or online. The link is available on our website. There will be no refunds issued after June 6, 2019.

EVENT: The tournament will begin with a ROUND ROBIN format with the following brackets: 3.0 and lower Mens Doubles, 3.5 Mens Doubles, 4.0 and above Mens Doubles, 3.0 and lower Womens Doubles, 3.5 Womens Doubles, 4.0 and above Womens Doubles. The space is limited to the first 60 teams to register. The "Team Skill Level" is determined by the **highest** skill level of each team member or USAPA rating. You **MUST** find your own partner. Additionally, both partners must register to be in the tournament. All games are self-officiated.

Awards: Medals will be awarded to the top three teams in each bracket. Every player will receive one t-shirt and swag is available. Water will be provided to registered participants.

Entry Fee: \$25.00 per person

Location of play: Rouse Park is host to six Pickleball courts in the South West corner of the park, however seating is extremely limited, so please bring your own chair. A food vendor will be available for the function. Please no glass bottles at this event. Parking is available in the large parking lot, adjacent to the softball fields at 1600 Park Ave. Parking at the Dewy St. lot will be limited due to vendors.
